\* AT 945 AM PST AUTOMATED RAINGAGE AND DOPPLER RADAR DATA INDICATED MORE BANDS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY RAIN WERE MOVING ONSHORE INTO THE NORTH BAY COUNTIES. PERIODS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY RAIN ARE EXPECTED TO CONTINUE THROUGH THE REST OF TODAY AND INTO THE EVENING COMMUTE. PONDING OF WATER ON ROADWAYS WILL CREATE HAZARDOUS DRIVING CONDITIONS. IN ADDITION...SMALL CREEKS MAY RISE QUICKLY WITH SEVERAL HOURS OF MODERATE TO HEAVY RAIN. RAIN RATES MAY EXCEED 1/2 INCH PER HOUR WITH 1/4 INCH PER HOUR EXPECTED TO BE COMMON FOR SEVERAL HOURS THIS AFTERNOON AND EARLY THIS EVENING ACROSS THE NORTH BAY COUNTIES.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

RUNOFF FROM HEAVY RAINFALL IS EXPECTED TO CAUSE PONDING OR FLOODING ON SOME ROADWAYS...POOR DRAINAGE AREAS AND LOW LYING SPOTS. ALSO... HEAVY RAINFALL IS EXPECTED TO CAUSE ELEVATED LEVELS ON SMALL CREEKS AND STREAMS AND MAY CAUSE FLOODING OF SOME.

ALLOW EXTRA TIME TO GET TO YOUR DESTINATION. IF WATER COVERS THE ROADWAY DO NOT CROSS IT. THE WATER MAY BE TOO DEEP TO ALLOW YOUR VEHICLE TO CROSS SAFELY.

A FLOOD ADVISORY MEANS THAT NUISANCE FLOODING IS OCCURRING OR IS EXPECTED.
